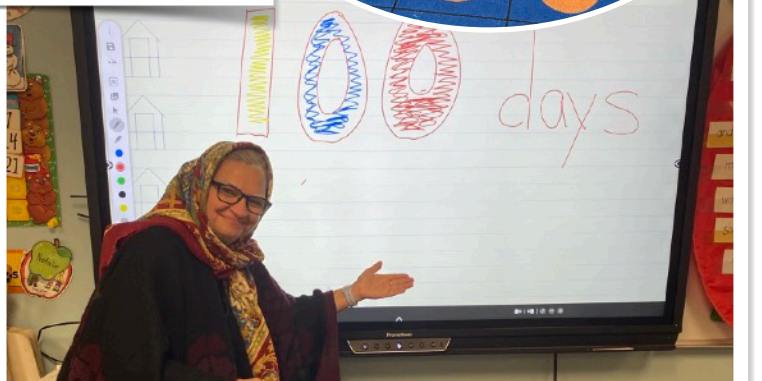
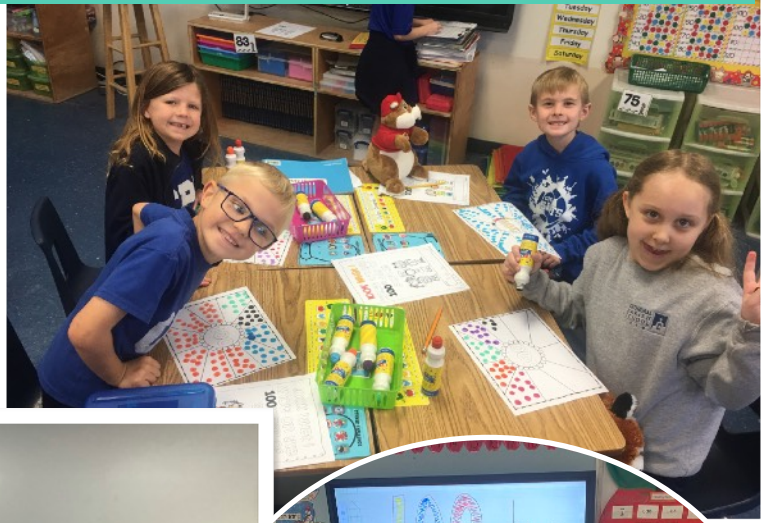

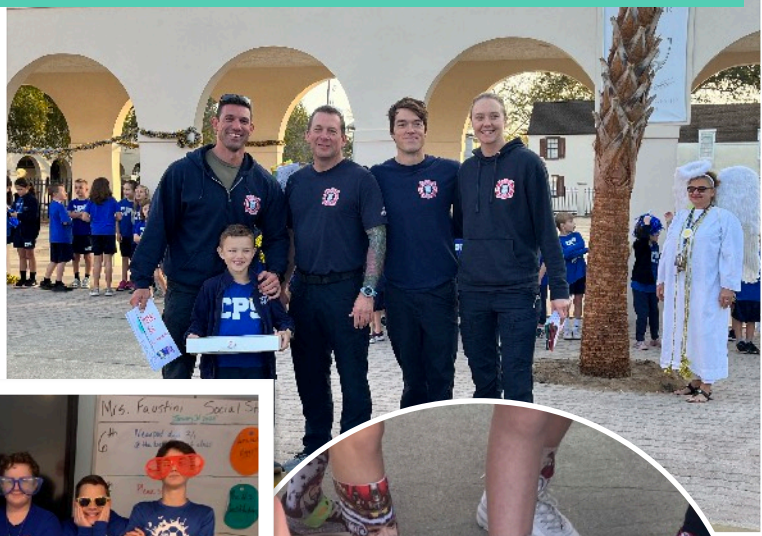

## SJA Theatre News

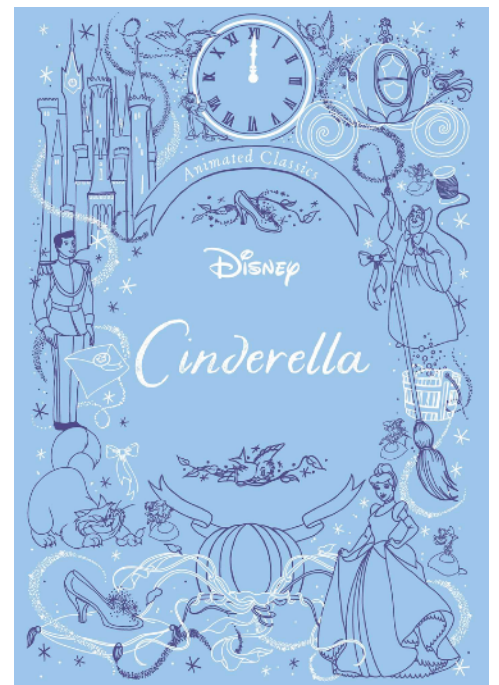
The spring musical is *Cinderella*
