The competition starts at the CPS level and then to district, regional and state competitions.


Soccer Challenge Rules Knights of Columbus Council 611 Cathedral Basilica of St Augustine



- 1. Safe Environment certified parishioners will be attending the event.
- 2. Contestants need to fill in their gender, age and all the requested information. A parent or guardian should sign and date the form. Bring the **Knights of Columbus Soccer Challenge Entry Form/Score Sheet** with


you the day of the competition. This will make your check in process as efficient as possible.


- 3. Spectators are welcome and will be asked to view the contest from the spectator area only. This provides a safe contest area free from distractions.
- 4. No personal soccer balls are allowed in the competition area (please leave them at home).
- 5. AGE SPECIFICATIONS: Kids kick in age brackets as determined by their age as of January 1, 2024.
 - a. Boys & Girls ages 9, 10, 11: Use a regulation-size #4 soccer ball and kick 10 yds from the goal.
 - b. Boys & Girls ages 12, 13, 14: Use a regulation-size #5 soccer ball and kick 12 yds from the goal.
- 6. The goal will be divided into a series of five scoring zones. The upper corners of the goal will be designated as 20-point zones. The lower corners will be designated as 10-point zones and the central region is a five-point zone.
- 7. SCORING: Each contestant receives three practice kicks followed by 15 penalty kicks from the designated penalty line for their age group. Points will be awarded depending upon the area of the scoring zones through which the ball passes.
- 8. Normal rules of soccer regarding penalty kicks apply for all levels of competition.



- 10. Scorers should record shots made and missed according to the instructions on the entry form/score sheet.
- 11. All scores should be verified before the next contestant is allowed to shoot.
- 12. Judges and scorers are given final authority in verifying all scores and violations.
- 13. In the event a tie breaker is necessary, each contestant will have the opportunity to take three kicks from a position three yards behind the designated age penalty line. If the contestants are still tied they will then continue to take turns of three kicks each until a clear winner emerges.
- winner emerges.

 14. Winners in each bracket advance to the next level (District, Region and State). The international scores will be determined based upon score sheets submitted from the State level.


