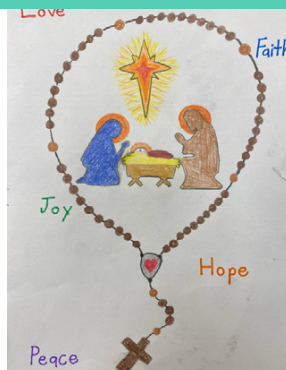

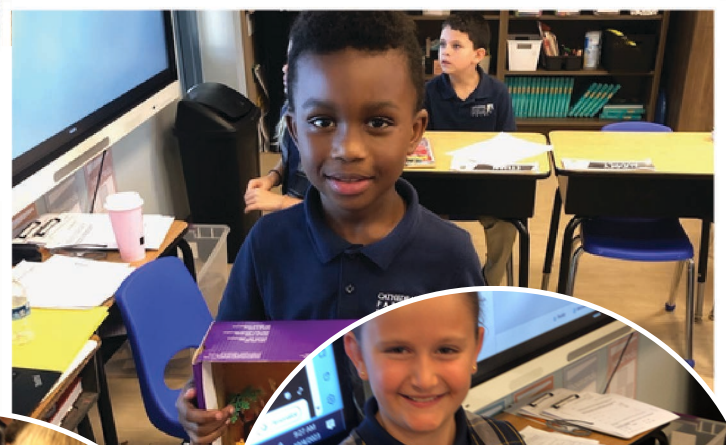
Elementary students enjoyed meeting firefighters from the St. Augustine Fire Department! Thank you for visiting us!
